SCHOOL CLOSES ON THURSDAY 1st APRIL AT 6:00pm



If your child shows any symptoms or tests positive anytime up to 6:00pm on Saturday 3rd April, 2021 contact the school by email to say that your child is symptomatic. Please state your child's name and whether you are getting your child tested. School email address to be used is testresults@stannes-brownedge.staffs.sch.uk



If your child shows any symptoms after 6.00pm on Saturday 3rd April school does not need to be contacted.

Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS

Test and Trace.



If your child tests positive but symptoms started after 6.00pm on Saturday 3rd
April (48hrs after school closed) your child must not return to school before the 10 days isolation period ends.

In this case please contact the school office on Monday 19th April.



When you get your result you must email school to say whether it is positive or negative.



If the result is positive, school will contact all children and staff in the appropriate bubble and anyone who may have been in close contact. Public health will also be notified.
