

ART: We will construct topographical models of our local environment including the landscape and local river catchment.



As part of our launch we will design and make a pizza.

D&T: The children will make a board game based upon the water cycle.



MUSIC: Our topic will be linked to song from Eurovision, giving children a chance to explore Winning songs from a variety of countries within Europe. They will evaluate their structure, then rank them. The data will be used to produce a class top ten.



PE:

During the Summer term the children will continue to build their physical endurance and coordination through take 10 activities. During their P.E lessons they will develop skills in athletics, tennis and cricket.



RE- Gospels What would Jesus do. Children will: compare their ideas with ways in which Christians interpret biblical texts, showing awareness of different interpretations.
Judaism: Children will be able to: explore the practices and beliefs of a Jewish person.



PSHE We will be exploring Brexit at an age-appropriate level and the current changes in Europe. We will look at democracy and how a referendum would work, using debating to discuss key issues.

HISTORY: Explore the historical evidence that was left behind following the eruption of Vesuvius and how reliable sources are to provide evidence.



GEOGRAPHY: Describe the physical aspects of rivers, mountains and the water cycle. We will use fieldwork techniques on our trip to Barlaston or local catchment to observe and measure physical features of a river. We will use maps to locate places in Britain and Europe and describe geographical terms. We will employ the use of 4 figure grid referencing to identify locations around our local area.

Maths:

Children will focus on consolidating the 4 operations, number facts as well as lots of practical maths relating to our topic work.
