RE : SCHOOL UNIFORM

After consultation with the School Council, Parent Forum and School Governors, St. Anne's C.E. Primary School have decided to introduce school ties for Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6) from the start of the new academic year, September 2018.

The school have decided to purchase the school ties for Key Stage 2 to minimise the cost to parents. The ties will be clip-on ties for ease of changing during P.E. days. The ties must be worn to school every day.

Therefore, it is more appropriate that children wear red V-neck sweatshirts (or cardigans) to school from September. We are aware some parents might have already purchased round-neck sweatshirts or be using brothers or sisters sweatshirts. As a result, for the academic year 2018-19 round-neck sweatshirts will still be permitted before being phased out completely by September 2019.

Children will also be required to wear white collared shirts. Polo shirts will not be permitted. The school uniform will be as follows:

- Red V-neck sweatshirt / cardigan
- Black or grey trousers / skirt / pinafore dress
- White collared shirt
- Sensible black shoes

In the summer, a red/white gingham dress (without tie) or short grey / black trousers may be worn.

As a reminder P.E. uniform consists of the following:

- White polo shirt
- Dark shorts
- Pumps
- Tracksuit (outdoor P.E.)
- Trainers (outdoor P.E.)
- P.E. kits must be in school every day

Children should also have long hair tied back and children must ensure that bows in hair are small and not large.

Whilst the wearing of jewellery is discouraged, earrings (small, plain stud only) are permitted; however children should be able to remove them themselves. If your child is considering having their ears pierced this should be done over the summer holidays to minimise disruption to P.E. lessons. Plasters are not allowed to cover the stud.

School sweatshirts, cardigans and polo shirts (P.E.) are available embroidered from Motif Marketing shop in Milton. We are also looking at giving parents the option of purchasing embroidered uniform through Tesco too.
